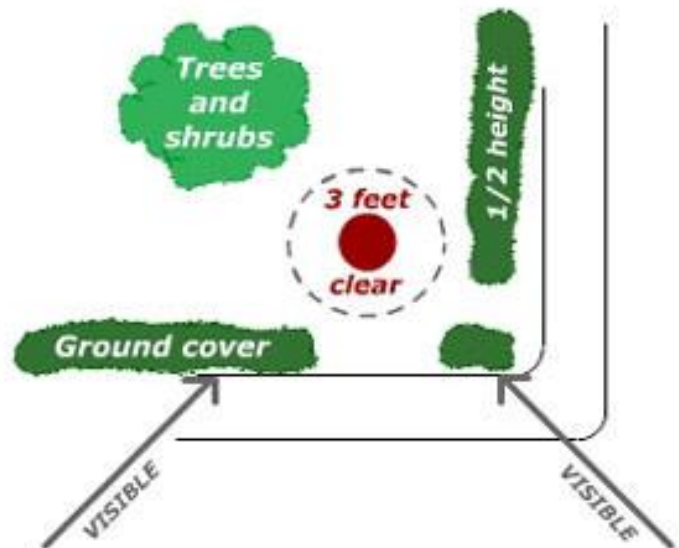
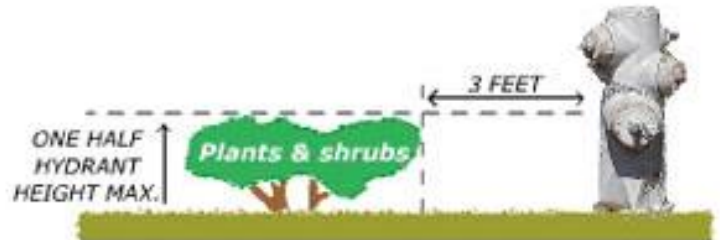

### Know Your Maintenance Responsibility

North Table Mountain Water and Sanitation District (NTM) is responsible for maintenance and repair of water and sewer mains throughout the District. NTM is also responsible for water service lines from the main to the meter pit, including the meter. Are you aware that you are responsible for repairs to your water and sewer service lines and for maintaining landscaping around fire hydrants?

**Property Owners** are responsible for water service lines from the meter pit to and inside the house. They are responsible for maintaining the meter pit and ensuring that our crews have access to it. Please don't landscape over the meter lid or let it get buried with dirt and debris. Owners are also responsible for sewer service lines from the main to and inside the house.

In addition, those who have a fire hydrant in their yard are responsible for keeping the hydrant accessible and clear of growth and debris within 3 feet of the hydrant. Landscaping must be maintained so that at least the top half of the hydrant is visible from the street.



## Summer 2016 Outdoor Water Use

Effective May 1 to October 1

### Voluntary Restrictions

Water is a limited resource in our dry climate. Using water wisely not only saves you money, but it's the right thing to do. We are following Denver Water's 2016 summer watering rules

- Water during cooler times of the day — lawn watering is not allowed between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- Water no more than three days per week.
- Do not allow water to pool in gutters, streets and alleys.
- Do not waste water by letting it spray on concrete and asphalt.
- Repair leaking sprinkler systems within 10 days.
- Do not irrigate while it is raining or during high winds.
- Use a hose nozzle with a shut-off valve when washing your car.
